\* Incidents involving a group of unknown type are arbitrarily placed in the Human Smuggling category. Some groups may have been drug smugglers but could not be confirmed with available information.

\*\* A single Drug Incident may involve more than one Drug Sub-Type. For example, a Load Truck and a group of drug packers could be apprehended in the same incident.

\*\*\* The combined total of illegal aliens and drug smugglers reported by Border Patrol agents "in the clear" or captured on video. There are many groups being worked during any 24 hour period where the size of the group can not be determined. Less than one third of all incidents contain a Body Count. This data is not useful for determining the actual number of bodies sighted, pursued or apprehended; nor does it indicate how many illegal border crossers enter the monitoring area.

1. Vehicle used to transport drugs or for re-supply. Includes ATVs. Does not include vehicles used for human smuggling. Sighted, pursued or seized.
2. Ultra-lights and other aircraft used to transport drugs. Sighted or seized.
3. Drug backpackers/mules transporting drugs on foot or using pack animals. Sighted, pursued or apprehended.
4. Drug Scouts and/or Lookout Posts used by Scouts, or ReSupply group or Rip Crew. Sighted, pursued, apprehended or dismantled.
5. Abandoned or hidden cache of drugs or a Resupply cache. No load vehicles or backpackers at location.
6. Confirmed drug incident, but insufficient data to determine if a load vehicle, drug scouts or drug packers.

"Weapon Involved" is anecdotal information to sub-types 1-6. Includes any device that can injure or kill.

"Homicide" is anecdotal information to sub-types 1-6.
